

Cupid's Wheel of Fortune

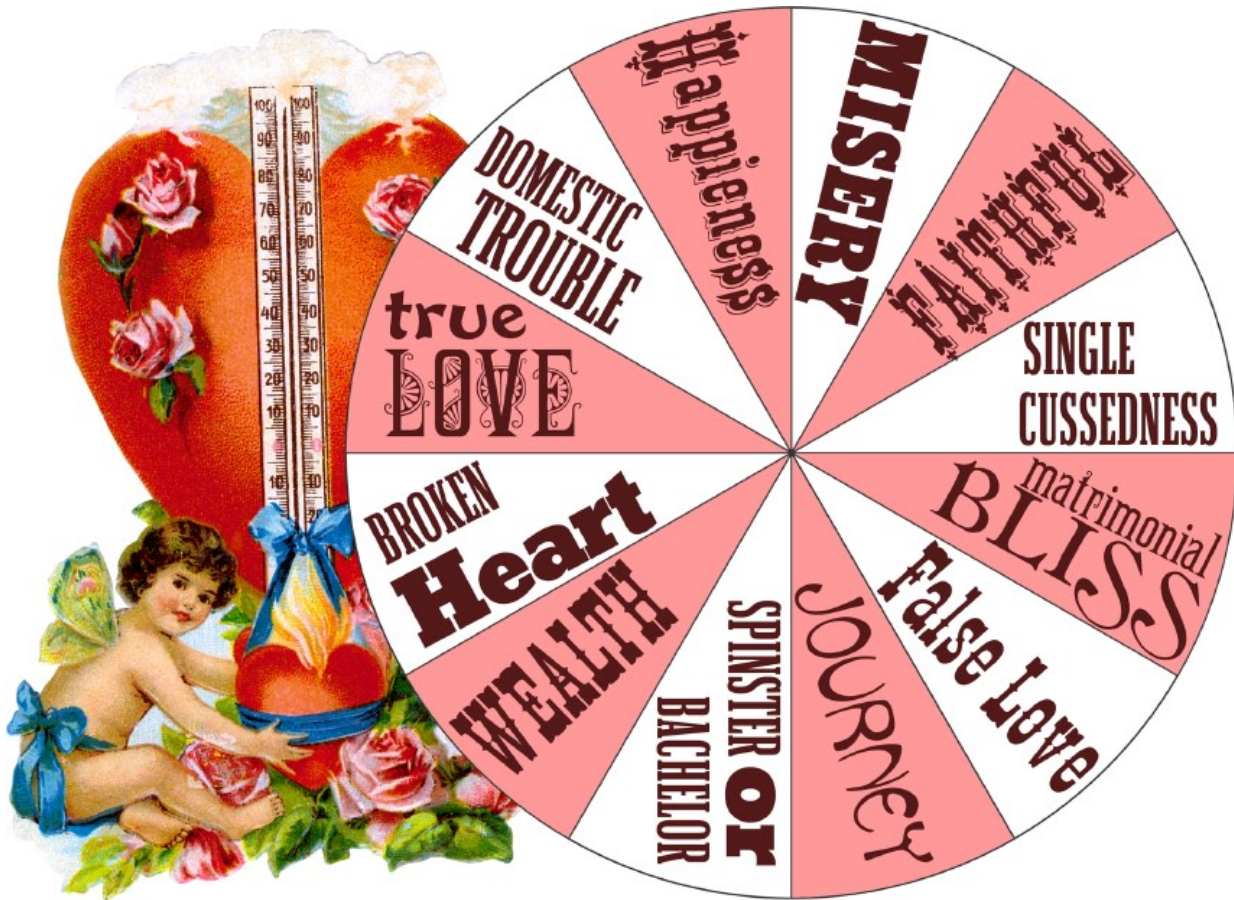
Cupid's Wheel of Fortune is an adaptation of a 1923 parlor game. I've also made a "blank" wheel that you can use to write in your own fortunes. Print, cut and assemble by fastening the red indicator to the center of the wheel, and let each player have a spin to see what Cupid's wheel has to tell him.



How I made a smooth spinning spinner.

After inserting an eyelet onto both the spinner and the center of the wheel, I mounted the wheel onto the box lid from a cardboard jewelry gift box. I then joined the spinner to the wheel using a push pin. This makes for a smoother spinning spinner. I found that just fastening the two together using brass fasteners didn't allow for much spinning action, and who wants to end up with "False Love" all the time?
